All uniform items are to be purchased from our official uniform supplier, Stitches (www.stitches.ae).

All uniforms **must** be of a respectable length (skirts and shorts for girls should reach to the knee).

PE shorts should be a reasonable length and leggings should be appropriate if your child chooses to wear these.

Footwear:

- Plain black (no white or colour) shoes which the student can manage by themselves and plain white socks or black tights (girls) or dark socks (boys). High heeled shoes and sandals are **not** permitted.
- Trainers or sports shoes should be worn on P.E. days. Crocs **are not** permitted, apart from during swimming lessons. Trainers should be worn for the rest of the day.

School Bags:

- A book bag or backpack is available from Stitches. Parents may purchase their own bags or backpacks.

Hair/Hair Covering/Nail/Make up:

- Hair longer than collar length should be fastened back for P.E. and practical Science lessons.
- Hair may not be dyed any colour other than a student's natural hair colour. If this occurs, students will not be permitted in school until their hair is returned to their natural colour.
- Minimal make up may be worn, but should be subtle.
- Acrylic/false nails **must not** be worn. Natural nail colour only is allowed.

Jewellery:

- Students should not wear excessive amounts of jewellery. It is not advisable to wear expensive jewellery to school and the school takes no responsibility for lost or broken items during the day.

The following **are** permitted:

- **Earrings:** 1 pair of small studs which **must** be removed for P.E. lessons
- **Necklaces:** one necklace which should not be visible
- **Watch:** Watches may be worn. Smart watches are **not** permitted. Students will be required to put these in a Yondr pouch (Secondary).
- **No other jewellery is permitted.**
Failure to comply with policy will result in confiscation.

This is Me / Non-Uniform Days:

- Culturally sensitive clothing must be worn, e.g. appropriate length skirts/shorts, midriff and shoulders covered.

Additional Information:

- Students are required to attend school wearing P.E. clothes on the days of P.E. and swimming lessons. Swimming kit should be packed separately.
- The school applies a 'No hat, no play' policy which is **mandatory** for FS and Primary students.
- Please clearly label all uniform items with your child's name.

Consequences:

- **Full** consequences for non-compliance of the 'Uniform Policy' can be found in DHA's 'Behaviour Policy'
- In the Secondary School, if a student fails to wear the correct uniform they will be issued with (-2) behaviour points and parents will be contacted.
- If a student fails to correct their uniform within a given timeframe they will not be permitted in class until the uniform is corrected.
